1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill Nos. 865 & 866, Page 1, Section A, Line 4, by inserting after all of said section and line  
3 the following:

5 "195.430. 1. There is hereby established in the state treasury the "Controlled Substance  
6 Abuse Prevention Fund", which shall consist of all fees collected by the department of health and  
7 senior services for the issuance of registrations to manufacture, distribute, or dispense controlled  
8 substances. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170  
9 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and  
10 moneys in the fund shall be used solely for the operation, regulation, enforcement, and educational  
11 activities of the bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs. Notwithstanding the provisions of section  
12 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert  
13 to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the  
14 same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments  
15 shall be credited to the fund.

16 2. All fees authorized to be charged by the department shall be transmitted to the  
17 department of revenue for deposit in the state treasury for credit to the fund, to be disbursed solely  
18 for the payment of operating expenses of the bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs to conduct  
19 inspections, enforce controlled substances laws and regulations, provide education to health care  
20 professionals and the public, and to prevent abuse of controlled substances.

21 3. Any moneys appropriated or made available by gift, grant, bequest, contribution, or  
22 otherwise to carry out the purposes of this section shall be paid to and deposited in the controlled  
23 substances abuse prevention fund.

24 195.435. The bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs shall employ no less than one  
25 investigator for every two thousand five hundred controlled substance registrants."; and
