notified by the federal department of homeland security that the department of revenue is able to issue driver's licenses or identification cards that comply with the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, as amended. Once the department of revenue is so notified, it shall give notice of the same to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president pro tem of the senate and the revisor of statutes. The department of revenue shall then issue driver's licenses and identifications in accordance with subsection 4 of this section."; and

"6.
