FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight notes this proposal permits a school district to incorporate a study of the criminal justice system into the school district's existing political science curriculum. Any fiscal impact would be based on the district's decision to add to their curriculum. Oversight will not show a direct fiscal impact for this proposal.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Brentwood School District** assume this may cost \$2,048 for curriculum development.

Officials at the **Cassville School District** assume an impact of \$12,500.

Officials at the **Shell Knob** assume this would have a fiscal impact but it is unknown at this time.

Officials at the **Carondelet Leadership Academy, Chilhowee, East Newton, Eldon, Everton, Fox C-6, Grain Valley R-V, Kansas City, Kearney, Macon County R-IV, New Haven, Parkway, Pettis County R-XII, Riverview Gardens, Sarcoxie, Smithville, St. Charles, St. Elizabeth, Warren County R-III, Webster Groves, West Plains** and the **Wright City R-II** school districts each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective districts.

Officials at the **Kingston School District** assume no fiscal impact as they are a K-8 school district.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
