ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** and the **Department of Higher Education** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective department.

Officials at the **State Technical College of Missouri** assume this may have a positive impact on the College.

Oversight notes this proposal would allow the State Technical College of Missouri to work with public high schools to offer dual credit courses. Oversight assumes this would not have a fiscal impact on the College unless they chose to offer such classes. If they chose to offer the classes then the tuition from the class would cover the cost of the class and therefore, this would not have a net fiscal impact on the College.
