FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** assume this proposal makes changes to the funding formula. This change will result in a fiscal impact only if the formula is fully funded. There will be an undetermined increase in cost to the formula by the inclusion of charter schools in the schools that can count preschool children in the Average Daily Attendance for state aid purposes. The potential cost could exceed \$1 million.

Oversight notes that DESE and the Office of Administration's Division of Budget and Planning were not able to provide Oversight with a projection of when the foundation formula may be fully funded. This proposal has a provision that may not have a fiscal impact until such time as the formula is fully funded. Oversight for fiscal note purposes is showing the impact of that provision as if the formula were fully funded.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


This bill specifies that charter schools become eligible to receive state funding for early childhood education at the same time as the district in which they are located becomes eligible.
