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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** assume from this proposal there will most likely be significant savings to the City, although the amount of savings cannot be determined at this time. By allowing municipalities to use the design-build procurement method for Water Department facilities, the City will be afforded the opportunity to consider the most efficient method for building a project. As a result, the City will most likely see increased funds in its capital account which may allow the flexibility to consider more innovative approaches in facility design and operation.

Officials at the Office of Administration's Division of Purchasing and Materials Management and the Division of Facilities Management, Design and Construction, the Department of Economic Development and the Department of Natural Resources each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at St. Louis County, the Callaway County Commission, the Laclede County Public Administrator Office and the City of Jefferson each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Officials at the University of Missouri System, the State Technical College of Missouri, the University of Central Missouri, the Northwest Missouri State University, the Missouri Western State University and the Metropolitan Community College each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Officials at the **Stoddard County Public Administrator Office** responded, but did not provide a response to Oversight's request for fiscal impact for this proposal.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

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FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act authorizes any political subdivision to use a design-build contractor for waste water and water treatment projects. The Department of Economic Development is required to consider design-build waste water or water treatment projects when disbursing grants under the Community Development Block Grant program. The Department of Natural Resources is prohibited from precluding design-build or sole source contracts from being considered for funding from the Water and Wastewater Loan Fund.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
