accountant to represent a client before the Administrative Hearing

Commission in matters relating to an assessment or reassessment of taxes.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Revenue**, the **State Tax Commission**, the **Administrative Hearing Commission**, the **City of Columbia**, the **City of Kansas City**, and the **County of St. Louis** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
