Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Corrections**, the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services**, the **Office of State Courts Administrator** and the **Office of State Public Defender** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact. However, in response to similar legislation from the current session (SB 644), AGO officials assumed any costs incurred by their organization would be absorbable within current funding levels.
