**Bill Summary:** This proposal extends the expiration date on the authority of the commission of a regional jail district to submit a ballot proposal imposing a sales tax to September 30, 2028.

State Fiscal Highlights

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis


**Oversight** was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **Office of Administration's Division of Budget & Planning**, the **Office of the State Auditor** and the **Office of the State Treasurer** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

In response to similar legislation from 2015 (HCS for HB 639), officials at the **Department of Revenue**, the **Office of the Secretary of State** and the **State Tax Commission** each assumed no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

FISCAL ANALYSIS (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
