Bill Summary: This proposal prohibits a school district from entering into a contract with any teacher for unpaid leave that results in the teacher receiving funds from the district when another organization is reimbursing the district.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight notes this proposal would prohibit a school district from paying a teacher who is on “unpaid leave” regardless of the source of the payment. Oversight assumes this proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Concordia School District** is not aware of a situation in which a teacher on unpaid leave would get paid.

Officials at the **New Haven School District** assume the only time the district believes this may impact the district is when they share teachers. They hire ½ FTE that is shared with other districts. If that teacher is on unpaid leave in one district and not the other then problems could arise with the teacher contract. The district is not be able to determine a cost at this time.

Officials at the **Webster Groves School District** assume they are not able to determine a fiscal impact as the proposal is unclear.

Officials at the **Wright City R-II School District** assume that in most years this would be no impact.

Officials at the **Carondelet Leadership Academy, Everton, Kansas City, Malta Bend, Middle Grove, Pettis County R-XII** and the **Seymour R-II** school districts each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **St. Elizabeth R-IV School District** responded to Oversight’s request but felt no fiscal impact could be determined as the proposal language is unclear.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
