Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Natural Resources and the Department of Public Safety's Division of Fire Safety each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at the Cole County Sheriff's Department, the Columbia Police Department, the Jefferson City Police Department, the Springfield Police Department and the St. Louis County Justice Services each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.
