Bill Summary: This proposal requires that nonprofit sewer companies be considered

sewer companies to which a homeowner's association shall convey wastewater systems even if restrictive covenants do not specifically allow

it.

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume this proposal will not have a fiscal impact on their organization.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
