# ASSUMPTION

**Oversight** was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** defer to Department of Transportation for fiscal impact.

Officials from the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Department of Health and Senior Services, and the Missouri Department of Conservation each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

In response to a similar proposal from this session, SB 1023, officials from the **Department of Transportation** and the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
