FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at St. Louis County, the Callaway County Commission and the Cole County Sheriff's Department each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Oversight assumes this proposal specifies that the county coroner need not be notified and no investigation is necessary for a death that occurs under hospice care if the treating physician certifies the death of the patient.
