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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight assumes there would be cost associated with this proposal but is unclear on the amount. Therefore, Oversight will assume a negative unknown until a response from Office of the State Courts Administrator (OSCA) is received.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This bill specifies that by January 1, 2018, every court must phase in equipment that allows the court to retain audio recordings from trial or other court proceedings for a minimum of one year.
