FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight notes this proposal would allow home school students to participate in Missouri State High School Activities Association activities.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight assumes this proposal would not have a fiscal impact on the school districts.

Officials at the **Webster Groves School District** assume no impact unless additional equipment is needed.

Officials at the **West Plains School District** assume this would result in additional costs for providing adequate equipment and uniforms.

Officials at the Everton, Macon County R-IV, Malta Bend, New Haven, Pettis County R-XII, Wright City R-II school districts each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the Chillicothe R-II School District responded but did not indicate a fiscal impact.
