AN ACT

To amend chapter 1, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the protection of parental rights.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 1, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 1.250, to read as follows:

1.250. 1. (1) The liberty of a parent to direct the upbringing, education, and care of his or her child is a fundamental right.

3 (2) Neither the state of Missouri nor any political subdivision of this state shall
4 infringe this right without demonstrating a compelling governmental interest. Any law or
5 policy shall be narrowly tailored and by the least restrictive means to achieve such interest.
6 2. (1) This section applies to all laws of this state, and the implementation of such
7 laws, whether statutory or otherwise, and whether adopted before or after the enactment
8 of this section.

9 (2) Any statutory law enacted after the date of the enactment of this section is 10 subject to this section unless such law explicitly excludes such application by reference to 11 this section.
