AN ACT

To amend chapter 37, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to government efficiency.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 37, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 37.875, to read as follows:

37.875. 1. The office of administration shall contract for a government efficiency

- and reform review and analysis of the executive branch of state government, which shall be known as "MO GEAR". Such review and analysis shall be conducted by an out-of-state
- 4 entity that has no connections to the state of Missouri. The review and analysis shall
- 5 evaluate the efficiency and effectiveness of state government and identify specific strategies
- 6 for making state government more efficient and effective. The review and analysis may
- 7 examine entire departments, agencies, institutions, or other similar programs in different
- 8 departments. The review and analysis shall include an examination of the efficiency and
- 9 effectiveness of major management policies, practices, and functions pertaining to the 10 following areas:
- 11 (1) The statutory authority, funding sources, and functions of each department, 12 agency, institution, or program;
- 13 (2) The organizational structure and staffing patterns in place to perform these 14 functions and whether they are appropriate based on comparative data and other 15 reasonable staffing criteria;

(3) The measurement of each reviewed program's outcomes, overall performance, and success in accomplishing its mandated or stated mission and subsequent goals, considering the resources provided to the program;

- (4) State and local responsibilities for providing government services and funding for those services and whether these responsibilities should be reallocated;
 - (5) Personnel systems operations and management;
 - (6) State purchasing operations and management;
- (7) Information technology and telecommunications systems policy, organization, and management;
- (8) The identification of opportunities to reduce fragmentation, duplication, and related or overlapping services or activities through restructuring of departmental organizations and streamlining programs.
- 2. All executive branch departments, agencies, boards, commissions, authorities, and institutions, including all nonstate entities receiving state funds, shall be subject to review and analysis. The head of the department, agency, board, commission, authority, or institution shall ensure full cooperation with the office of administration and provide timely responses to the office of administration's request for information.
- 3. The office of administration shall work collaboratively with the state auditor to develop the review, analysis, and findings needed to produce a final report and recommendations to the governor and general assembly.
- 4. The contracting provisions relating to state purchasing and budget shall not apply to MO GEAR; however, the office of administration shall report all external contracts for consultants or professional services within thirty days of their execution to the joint committee on governmental accountability, the committee on government efficiency, the president pro tempore of the senate, and the speaker of the house of representatives.
- 5. The office of administration shall submit an interim report of the MO GEAR's analysis, findings, and recommendations to the governor, the president pro tempore of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the joint committee on government accountability, and the committee of government efficiency by February 15, 2017, and a final report by February 15, 2018.
- 6. Funds appropriated for MO GEAR shall be used to contract with consultants and other experts and to pay for travel, postage, printing, planning, and other related costs as needed to accomplish the objectives specified under this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, funds appropriated for MO GEAR shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund.
