AN ACT

To repeal section 491.050, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the admissibility of municipal offenses to prove credibility.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

491.050. Any person who has been convicted of a crime is, notwithstanding, a competent

witness; however, any prior **convictions of municipal offenses or** criminal convictions may be

proved to affect his or her credibility in a civil or criminal case and, further, any prior pleas of

4 guilty, pleas of nolo contendere, and findings of guilty in state or municipal court may be

5 proved to affect his **or her** credibility in a criminal case. Such proof may be either by the record

or by his or her own cross-examination, upon which he or she must answer any question

relevant to that inquiry, and the party cross-examining shall not be concluded by his or her
