## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to article I of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section relating to the recognition of daylight saving time.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next

- 2 following the first Monday in November, 2016, or at a special election to be called by the
- 3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for
- 4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to article I of the Constitution of the state of
- 5 Missouri:

Section A. Article I, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding one new section,

- 2 to be known as section 38, to read as follows:
  - Section 38. All areas of this state shall be exempted from the daylight saving time
- 2 provisions of 15 U.S.C. Section 260a. Beginning on the first Sunday in March of 2018, the
- 3 state and its political subdivisions and agencies shall switch clocks to daylight saving for
- 4 the last time and the use of daylight saving time for public purposes will be eliminated.
- 5 After this time, daylight saving time will no longer be recognized as the official time of this
- 6 state. This act shall become effective if and only if two states adjacent to Missouri pass a
- 7 measure substantially similar in content to regulate daylight saving time.
