## AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to police reporting of information.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 590.1030, to read as follows:

590.1030. 1. The Missouri state highway patrol shall report to the United States 2 Department of Justice:

3 (1) Any incident involving the shooting of a civilian by a Missouri state highway
4 patrol officer; and

5 (2) Any incident in which the use of force by a Missouri state highway patrol officer
6 against a civilian results in serious bodily injury or death.

7
2. For each incident reported under subsection 1 of this section, the information
8 reported to the department of justice shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

9 (1) A description and identification of each individual who was shot, injured, or 10 killed;

11 (2) The date, time, and location of the incident;

12 (3) Whether the civilian was armed, and if so, the type of weapon the civilian had;

- 13 (4) The number of officers involved in the incident;
- 14 (5) The number of civilians involved in the incident; and
- 15 (6) A brief description regarding the circumstances surrounding the incident.
- 16 **3. Incidents required to be reported under this section shall be reported by the**

17 Missouri state highway patrol within twenty-four hours of the incident's occurrence.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
