### AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to police reporting of information.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 590.1030, to read as follows:

**590.1030. 1. The Missouri state highway patrol shall report to the United States Department of Justice:**

**(1) Any incident involving the shooting of a civilian by a Missouri state highway patrol officer; and**

**(2) Any incident in which the use of force by a Missouri state highway patrol officer against a civilian results in serious bodily injury or death.**

**2. For each incident reported under subsection 1 of this section, the information reported to the department of justice shall include, but not be limited to, the following:**

**(1) A description and identification of each individual who was shot, injured, or killed;**

**(2) The date, time, and location of the incident;**

**(3) Whether the civilian was armed, and if so, the type of weapon the civilian had;**

**(4) The number of officers involved in the incident;**

**(5) The number of civilians involved in the incident; and**

**(6) A brief description regarding the circumstances surrounding the incident.**

**3. Incidents required to be reported under this section shall be reported by the Missouri state highway patrol within twenty-four hours of the incident's occurrence.**
