### AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to certain investigations by the Missouri state highway patrol.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 590.1035, to read as follows:

**590.1035. 1. The Missouri state highway patrol shall investigate the following:**

**(1) Any incident involving the shooting of a civilian by a law enforcement officer in a city not within a county or in a county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants;**

**(2) Any incident involving the shooting of a law enforcement officer by a civilian in a city not within a county or in a county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants;**

**(3) Any incident in which the use of force by a law enforcement officer against a civilian results in serious bodily injury or death in a city not within a county or in a county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants; and**

**(4) Any incident in which the use of force by a civilian against a law enforcement officer results in serious bodily injury or death in a city not within a county or in a county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants.**

**2. The local law enforcement agency shall reimburse the Missouri state highway patrol for any expenses incurred by the patrol in investigating incidents under subsection 1 of this section.**
