AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to department of conservation resident permits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 252.285, to read as follows:

252.285. Any United States citizen who is not a resident of Missouri but is employed at least forty hours per week in Missouri and pays income taxes in Missouri who applies for a hunting, fishing, or trapping license or permit with the department of conservation shall be issued a resident hunting, fishing, or trapping license or permit if all other department regulations are met. Such nonresident shall pay the same fee as a resident applicant for such license or permit.
