AN ACT

To amend chapter 105, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to peace officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 105, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 105.241, to read as follows:

**105.241. 1. Any peace officer licensed under chapter 590 and employed by any city,
2 county, or political subdivision of the state shall have the right to carry a firearm at all
3 times.**

**4 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, a peace officer's
5 employer may temporarily suspend an officer's right to carry a firearm while on duty for
6 administrative, disciplinary, or medical purposes. A notice of suspension shall be supplied
7 to the peace officer in writing and shall include the reason for and the duration of the
8 suspension. Any suspension that extends beyond ninety days may be appealed to the
9 circuit court of the county in which the employer is located.**
