AN ACT

Relating to the designation of certain awareness months.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

	Whereas, cystic fibrosis, commonly referred to as "CF", is a genetic disease affecting
2	approximately 30,000 children and adults in the United States and nearly 70,000 children and
3	adults worldwide, 717 of whom live in Missouri; and
4	
5	Whereas, a defective gene causes the body to produce an abnormally thick, sticky mucus
6	that clogs the lungs, and these secretions produce life-threatening lung infections and obstruct
7	the pancreas, preventing digestive enzymes from reaching the intestines to help break down and
8	absorb food; and
9	
10	Whereas, more than 10 million Americans are symptomless carriers of the defective CF
11	gene, and CF occurs in approximately one of every 3,500 live births in the United States; and
12	
13	Whereas, the median age of survival for a person with CF is 39.3 years; and
14	
15	Whereas, with advances in the treatment of CF, the number of adults with CF has
16	steadily grown, and approximately 900 new cases of CF are diagnosed each year; and
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18	Whereas, fifty percent of the CF population is 18 years of age and older, and people with
19 20	CF have a variety of symptoms attributed to the more than 1,800 mutations of the CF gene; and
21	Whereas, infant blood screening to detect genetic defects is the most reliable and least
22	costly method to identify persons likely to have CF; and
23	
24	Whereas, early diagnosis of CF permits early treatment and enhances quality of life and
25	longevity and the treatment of CF depends on the stage of the disease and the organs involved;
26	and
27	
28	Whereas, clearing mucus from the lungs is an important part of the daily CF treatment
29	regimen, and other types of treatments include inhaled antibiotics and pancreatic enzymes,
30	among others; and
31	
32	Whereas, there are 8 world-class treatment centers in Missouri which specialize in the
33	diagnosis of CF and the care of persons with CF; and
34	
35	Whereas, a critical component of treating patients with CF includes access to innovative
36	treatments, which can play a crucial role in the lives of patients with CF; and
37	
38	Whereas, improving the length and quality of life for people with CF starts with
39	awareness; and
40	
41	Whereas, the brachial plexus is a network of nerves that conducts signals from the spine
42	to the shoulder, arm, and hand; and
43 44	Wheness injugate these nerves can result in last of muscle control or facting in the arm
44 45	Whereas, injury to these nerves can result in lack of muscle control or feeling in the arm or hand, including Erb's palsy:
46	or nand, meruding Ero's parsy.
47	Now Therefore Be It Resolved that the members of the House of Representatives of the
48	Ninety-eighth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby
49	designate the month of May of each year as "Cystic Fibrosis Awareness Month" and the month

50 of October of each year as "Brachial Plexus Awareness Month" in Missouri.

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51 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of 52 Representatives be instructed to send a properly inscribed copy of this resolution to the Governor 53 for his approval or rejection pursuant to the Missouri Constitution.

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
