3 4 5 6	WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Jewish Hospital of St. Louis states that the hospital's object and purpose is to conduct, support, and manage a hospital for the purpose of affording medical and surgical aid and care to sick or disabled persons, regardless of race or creed; and
8 9 10 11	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Constitution of the Jewish Hospital of St. Louis states that the hospital's object and purpose is to furnish adequate medical social services to the patients of any hospital, unit, division, institution, or agency it operates or maintains; and
12 13 14 15	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Constitution of the Jewish Hospital of St. Louis states that the hospital's object and purpose is to participate in the development of social and welfare and health programs in the community; and
16 17 18	WHEREAS, doctors, nurses, and other medical professionals take the Hippocratic Oath and swear to remember that they treat sick human beings, whose illness may affect the person's family and economic stability, and their responsibility includes these related problems; and

23	WHEREAS, the residents of these neighborhoods now have to travel to seek medical

**WHEREAS**, some residents of these neighborhoods cannot afford primary care and seek medical treatment in hospital emergency rooms out of necessity; and

**WHEREAS**, Barnes-Jewish Hospital closed medical facilities in these neighborhoods so that the residents have no emergency room nearby and are unable to seek any medical treatment:

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-eighth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby disapprove of the actions taken by Barnes-Jewish Hospital to close medical facilities in low-income and minority neighborhoods resulting in no viable medical treatment for the residents of those neighborhoods; and

 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Barnes-Jewish Hospital violated its own constitution and the Hippocratic Oath by closing treatment facilities in low-income and minority neighborhoods, by ending adequate medical social services in communities in need, and by terminating its social welfare and health programs in communities; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for each member of the board of directors of Barnes-Jewish Hospital and the following administrators of the Barnes-Jewish Hospital administration: the president; the vice president of diversity, inclusion, and equality; and the vice president of facilities and support services.
