1 **WHEREAS**, Missourians are increasingly using new technologies, including
2 smartphones, in their daily lives; and

4 **WHEREAS**, that usage includes core day-to-day functions like working, banking, and
5 shopping; and

7 **WHEREAS**, increasing convenience for our residents is one way to improve
8 quality-of-life; and

10 **WHEREAS**, there is both a financial and environmental cost of producing plastic
11 driver's licenses; and

13 **WHEREAS**, there is emerging technology that allows for secure, digital driver's licenses;

16 **WHEREAS**, numerous other states began experimenting with digital driver's licenses
17 in 2015; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the digital driver's license would be optional, not required.

21 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of
22 Representatives of the Ninety-eighth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate
23 concurring therein, hereby urge the the Motor Vehicle and Driver Licensing Division of the
24 Department of Revenue to study and consider issuing optional digital driver's licenses for
25 Missouri motorists; and

28 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the
29 Director of the Department of Revenue.
