AN ACT

To amend chapter 537, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to public safety officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 537, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 537.870, to read as follows:

537.870. 1. In addition to any other right of action or recovery otherwise available under the law, if any public safety officer is injured in the course of his or her official duties, the public safety officer shall have a cause of action for damages against the person or entity whose ordinary negligence created the emergency. This cause of action shall not exist against such officer's employer or against a political subdivision. The provisions of this section shall abrogate the common law doctrine commonly known as the "fireman's rule".

8 2. For purposes of this section, "public safety officer" includes, but is not limited 9 to, police officers, firefighters, ambulance personnel, emergency dispatchers, and 10 corrections officers.
