# **HOUSE BILL NO. 2553**

### 98TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

#### INTRODUCED BY REPRESENTATIVE PARKINSON.

### **AN ACT**

To repeal section 67.1736, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to metropolitan park and recreation districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 67.1736, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 67.1736, to read as follows:

67.1736. 1. Board members shall have the exclusive control of the expenditures of all money collected to the credit of the metropolitan park and recreation fund created pursuant to 2 sections 67.1754 and 67.1757, and of the supervision, improvement, care and custody of public 3 parks, neighborhood trails, recreational facilities and grounds owned, maintained or managed 4 by the metropolitan district. All moneys received for such purposes shall be deposited in the 5 treasury of the county providing the largest financial contribution to the district to the credit of 6 7 the metropolitan park and recreation fund and shall be kept separate and apart from the other 8 moneys of such county. The board shall have power to purchase or otherwise secure ground to 9 be used for such parks, neighborhood trails, recreational facilities and grounds, shall have power 10 to appoint suitable persons to maintain such parks, neighborhood trails, recreational grounds and 11 facilities and administer recreational programs and fix their compensation, and shall have power 12 to remove such appointees. The board shall keep accurate records of all its proceedings and actions and shall compile and publish reports of information relating to the metropolitan district 13 14 and to the board's functions and proceedings pursuant to the laws of this state.

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2. In addition to the reports required under subsection 1 of this section, the board 16 shall prepare a monthly report containing the following information:

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(1) All revenue collected under sections 67.1754 and 67.1757 on a quarterly basis;

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18 (2) All expenditures authorized on a quarterly basis;

19 (3) A list of all projects by county and municipality; and

20 (4) Any legal action brought or defended by the board or the district.

3. The monthly report shall be provided by the board to each county and municipality within the district and, on a semiannual basis, the board shall present the reports accumulated for the previous six months to the full governing body of each county and each municipality in the district.

4. The monthly report shall be available to the public in a format determined by
the board, upon approval by the governing body of each county and each municipality in
the district.

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
