AN ACT

To amend chapter 620, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a job training program for persons of low and moderate income.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 620, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 620.2558, to read as follows:

620.2558. 1. The department of economic development shall establish a job training program for persons of low and moderate income as defined in 42 U.S.C. Section 5302(a)(20). The program shall provide such persons with the necessary training that would allow them to find gainful employment in state-funded job positions in this state. The department shall market such program.

2. The department of economic development shall prepare and submit an annual report to the general assembly:

(1) Providing information on the recruitment process to fill state-funded job positions; and

(2) Providing information on the success of the job training program, including the number of persons who have completed the program.

3. This section shall become effective January 1, 2018.
