	WHEREAS, every person in Missouri and the United States deserves access to
2	affordable, quality health care; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, there is a growing crisis in health care in the United States, manifested in
5	rising health care costs, increased premiums, and greater out-of-pocket spending; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, since the enactment of the Affordable Care Act in 2010, the number of
8	uninsured Missourians has decreased from 15.2 percent in 2013 to 13.4 percent in 2014; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, there are still an estimated 253,000 uninsured Missourians who would gain
11	coverage if Missouri expanded Medicaid; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, beginning in 2014, the federal government covered the full cost of
14	expansion for three years for states that expanded Medicaid coverage; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, beginning in 2017, the rate of federal funding will decrease to 95%, with
17	the rate further decreasing to 94% in 2018, 93% in 2019, and 90% in 2020 and thereafter; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, President Obama has recently included a provision in his proposed budget
20	for 2017 that would provide all states three years of full federal funding for Medicaid expansion,
21	whether the state has already expanded or will do so in the future; and
22	WHEREAC HER ASSOCIATION IN THE STATE OF A COOLING
23	WHEREAS, H.R. 4588, the Incentivize Medicaid Expansion Act of 2016, would
24	similarly provide the same level of federal matching assistance for every state that chooses to
25	expand Medicaid coverage to newly eligible individuals, regardless of when such expansion
26	takes place; and
27	WHEREAC he are a disconding Medicaid according Missouries will be in a fix of 1 Objility in the
28	WHEREAS, by expanding Medicaid coverage, Missouri would bring in \$1.8 billion into
