HB 1380 -- ELECTION PROCEDURES

SPONSOR: English

Currently, election challenges may remain at polling places only during voting hours. This bill allows an election challenger to remain at a polling place until all procedures involving the counting, sealing, and transportation of ballots or election equipment has occurred and all other duties and procedures required under Sections 115.447 to 115.491, RSMo, are completed. Challengers will continue to be allowed at each place where absentee ballots are prepared for counting and counted.

This bill is the same as HB 1016 (2015).
