HB 1425 -- LICENSING OF CAMPERS AND TRAILERS

SPONSOR: Walker

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill allows a camping or fifth-wheel trailer that is more than 25 years old to be permanently registered upon payment of a \$25 registration fee. The bill also allows any person with license plates issued by the state of Missouri that are over 25 years old and the year of issuance is consistent with the year of manufacture for the camping or fifth-wheel trailer to register the plates as historic trailer plates.

This bill is the same as HCS HBs 35 and 323 (2015).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill will ease registration issues for camping or fifth-wheel trailers.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Walker.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
