

HB 1853 -- TOM BOLAND HIGHWAY

SPONSOR: Shumake

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 12 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Select Committee on State and Local Governments by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill designates the portion of U.S. Highway 61 from the intersection with Warren Barrett Drive continuing north through Hannibal to County Road 407 in Marion County as the "Tom Boland Highway."

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that Tom Boland served on the State Highway Commission for many years, maintains a great working relationship with the Missouri Department of Transportation, and should be recognized for his work.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Shumake and Jeff LaGarce, City of Hannibal.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
