HB 1860 -- REPRESENTATION DURING A ASSESSMENT HEARING

SPONSOR: Cross

This bill allows a tax preparer, enrolled agent, or certified public accountant to represent his or her client before the Administrative Hearing Commission in matters relating to an individual's assessment or reassessment of taxes or any other tax-related matter.

This bill authorizes an exemption from the real estate appraisers licensing requirements for anyone employed by the property owner or agent to represent the owner in any proceeding appealing the assessment of the owner's property before any board of equalization.

This bill is the same as HB 838 (2015).
