HB 1934 -- POLICE REPORTING OF INFORMATION

SPONSOR: Miller

This bill establishes the requirement that the Missouri State Highway Patrol report to the United States Department of Justice, within 24 hours, any incident involving the shooting of a civilian by a Missouri State Highway Patrol officer, and any incident involving use of force by a Missouri State Highway Patrol officer resulting in serious bodily injury or death. The various factors required to be included in the report are specified in the bill.
