HB 1936 -- SHERIFFS ASSISTING IN OTHER COUNTIES (Wilson)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness

This bill establishes that any sheriff, or deputy sheriff sent by a sheriff, responding to a request for assistance in another county is considered an employee of his or her sheriff's office and will be subject to benefits and provisions provided to him or her as an employee of his or her sheriff's office.

This bill is similar to SB 734 (2016).
