HB 1958 -- MEMORIAL HIGHWAY DESIGNATIONS

SPONSOR: Basye

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Select Committee on Rules by a vote of 7 to 0.

This bill designates the portion of U.S. Highway 63 from Breedlove Drive to Peabody Road in Boone County as "U.S. Army Specialist Steven Paul Farnen Memorial Highway." It also designates the portion of U.S. Highway 63 from the interchange with Discovery Parkway to Interstate 70 in Boone County as "U.S. Navy Lieutenant Patrick Kelly Conner Memorial Highway."

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the highway designation pays tribute to two individuals who gave their lives in Operation Desert Storm.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Basye.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
