HB 1986 -- TEXT MESSAGING WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE

Currently, any person 21 years old or younger is prohibited from sending, writing, or reading a text or electronic message while operating a motor vehicle upon the highways of Missouri. This bill removes the age restriction and makes it illegal for any person, regardless of age, to send, write, or read a text or electronic message while operating a motor vehicle upon the highways of Missouri.
