HB 2104 -- LIQUOR CONTROL (Alferman)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Emerging Issues

This bill expands the authorization for licensed liquor retailers to use table tap dispensing systems that allow patrons to self-dispense up to 32 ounces of beer per patron to include self-dispensing of up to 16 ounces of wine per patron, and removes references to table taps and instead refers to self-dispensing systems.

This bill also provides that a person whose liquor license has been revoked will automatically be eligible for employment in an establishment holding a liquor license five years after the date of the revocation, and will be eligible to apply for a new liquor license issuable at the discretion of the Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control.

This bill is the similar to SB 859 (2016).
