

HB 2187 -- LANDS ACQUIRED THROUGH SETTLEMENTS

SPONSOR: Ross

This bill requires the Department of Natural Resources and all other state departments, agencies, or entities to sell at public auction any property interest to land in Oregon County purchased on or before August 28, 2016 through legal settlement funds administered by the Department of Natural Resources. If there is no purchaser, the property will revert to the ownership of Oregon county government.

After August 28, 2016, the bill also prohibits the department and all other state departments, agencies, or entities from purchasing property interest in Oregon County. Any taxpayer in the state has standing to enforce these requirements and will be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees.

This section expires on August 28, 2017.

This bill is the same as HB 1782 (2016).
