HB 2264 -- RIGHT TURNS ON RED LIGHTS

SPONSOR: Korman

This bill repeals the provision requiring the driver of a vehicle to come to a full and complete stop before cautiously entering an intersection to make a right turn at a red traffic control signal except at specified intersections. The bill requires the driver to slow to a speed that is deemed safe when considering the number of moving vehicles in motion before cautiously entering an intersection to make a right turn at a red traffic control signal except at specified intersections.

This bill is the same as HB 534 (2015).
