HCS HB 2380 -- SPECIAL PERSONALIZED LICENSE PLATES

SPONSOR: Kolkmeyer

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with Amendments" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Select Committee on State and Local Government by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill provides that the owner of a motor vehicle, other than an apportioned or commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of 24,000 pounds, may apply for an existing or hereafter created special personalized license plate. Currently, the owner of a motor vehicle, other than an apportioned motor vehicle or commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of 18,000 pounds, may apply for a special personalized license plate.

The bill also removes the requirement that there be an accompanying list of at least 200 potential applicants for those owners seeking to apply for the Missouri Junior Golf Foundation special personalized license plate.

This bill is similar to HCS HB 1091 (2015).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill will increase revenue from specialized license plates.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Kolkmeyer.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
