HB 2391 -- OBSOLETE STATUTORY PROVISIONS

SPONSOR: Pierson

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Government Efficiency by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill repeals the requirement and procedures for state agencies distributing paper copies of performance and cost reports to the House of Representatives, Senate, Legislative Library, Missouri Supreme Court, and Governor.

This bill is the same as HB 605 (2015).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that most of the information involved is available and distributed electronically. Moreover, there would be a cost savings from repealing physical distribution requirements.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Pierson; Elizabeth Zerr; and the Missouri Secretary Of State.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
