HB 2413 -- REPORTING OF MENTAL CAPACITY TO POSSESS FIREARM

SPONSOR: Hill

This bill requires any health care professional who chooses to report to the federal government a patient's unstable mental capacity to possess a firearm shall notify the county sheriff of the patient's residence within 24 hours and the patient or the patient's representative by certified mail within 10 days of making the report. Failure to comply with the provisions of the bill is a class A misdemeanor and any false or incorrect information provided to the federal government must give the patient a private cause of action.
