HB 2419 -- CAMERA SYSTEMS IN CLASSROOMS

SPONSOR: Kelley

This bill requires that public schools install and maintain video camera systems in classrooms in which primarily children with special needs are taught. The contents of the recorded videos must be accessible to school administrators for at least 30 days from the day of the recording, and administrators may save the videos for longer than 30 days.

This bill also creates a "Classroom Camera Fund," which is to be used to install and maintain the camera systems. The fund will be maintained by the State Treasurer.
