## HB 2629 -- LICENSURE OF LAND SURVEYORS

This bill changes the law regarding the licensure of land surveyors. Specifically, the bill changes the educational requirements for applying for land surveyor-in-training and the requirements for licensure as a professional land surveyor. Beginning January 1, 2021, applicants for licensure as a professional land surveyor will need to have passed at least 15 semester hours of approved surveying course work, including at least five semester hours in legal aspects of land surveying. Any credit hours passed prior to applying for enrollment as a land surveyor-in-training will be allowed to count toward the required fifteen hours. This bill also specifies when an applicant for licensure as a professional land surveyor can claim professional field and office experience that he or she completed prior to enrolling as a land surveyor-in-training.
