

HB 2667 -- AMBULANCE DISTRICTS

SPONSOR: Shumake

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Local Government by a vote of 6 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Select Committee on State and Local Governments by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill repeals an outdated provision regarding the Missouri Uniform Law Enforcement System (MULES).

The bill also allows ambulance districts to adopt procedures for conducting fingerprint background checks on current and prospective employees and volunteers.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill was requested by sheriffs' departments and ambulance districts.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Shumake and the Ambulance District Association of Missouri.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
