

HJR 95 -- LOCAL VOTER APPROVAL OF TAX MODIFICATIONS

SPONSOR: Ellington

This house joint resolution proposes a constitutional amendment to the Missouri Constitution, prohibiting counties and other political subdivisions from authorizing redevelopment plans unless such plans are approved by a majority of the qualified voters of that county or political subdivision.

This resolution also contains a grandfathering clause, exempting already authorized redevelopment plans from the resolution unless a county or political subdivision tries to modify, amend, or expand such a redevelopment plan.

This bill is the same as HJR 91 (2016).
